## A Message from Fr. Matt ...

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today is two things. It is the Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time and it is the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. As Fr. Lou explained a few weeks ago in the bulletin, most of the time when a Feast Day falls on a Sunday, the Sunday supersedes the Feast and the Feast is either transferred or not celebrated that year. There is an exception when it is the Feast Day of the Patron of a Parish. So today, at Mater Dolorosa Church, it is the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. That's why we are having a big dinner in Chicora this weekend. It is our Feast Day! We need to celebrate. At our other two churches it is the Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Got it? Good.



Does it seem weird to celebrate a Feast that is about the sorrows and sufferings of a person? I guess it does seem weird. You wouldn't decorate the house and order a big cake to celebrate someone getting their hip replaced, would you? What would you put on the cake? "Hey, I bet rehab is going to be terrible!" But what we celebrate with Our Lady of Sorrows, the Mater Dolorosa, is the love that was shown her, and the love that she showed in enduring the suffering that came her way, as the Mother of Our Savior.

Love. Enduring Love. That is worth celebrating!

The Ordinary Time Readings this week speak of enduring love as well. The First Reading shows us God's love for His people, even when they turn their back on Him. How easy and actually, how just, it would have been for God to destroy the people Israel, who had made a fake god of their own and had decided to worship it. But God doesn't destroy them. God's love for them endures.

In the Second Reading, St. Paul tells us that Jesus came into the world to save sinners. In the Gospel, Jesus scandalizes the Pharisees because He welcomes sinners and eats with them! The whole Bible is the story of a God who meets people where they are and loves them. Now, God doesn't meet people where they are and say, "Everything that you are doing is ok." But God does say, "You are ok." In fact, more than ok, you are loved. God's love endures even our greatest sins.

So I have a challenge for you this week. I challenge you to make the Angels of God rejoice! Give the Angels a reason to party. How could you possibly do that? First, believe that you are loved. Believe that God runs out and meets you where you are and loves you. Second, repent of your sins. You need to do the first so that you can do the second.

You are a sinner and so am I. Well, good news for us, God wants to be with us. He welcomes us and eats with us and wants to walk with us and lead us in the right direction. God's love for you endures. No matter what you have done. That is a reason to celebrate. Believe it this week and then give the Angels a reason to celebrate with you.

All Grouping staff members can receive voice mail at any of the parish phone numbers. You don't have to figure out who is where; call any of the three parish offices. In emergencies, a voice mail left for one of the priests will cause a file of your voice message to be emailed to that priest.
