Celebrating Our Three Parish Patrons

When the saint that a parish is named for has a "feast" day, that patronal celebration is raised higher than a Feast to a Solemnity in that local parish. The readings, prayers, music, homily, and vestments proper for that saint take precedence, even over a Sunday. In fact, the celebration may even be transferred to the closest Sunday.

So, on **Sunday, September 15 at Mater Dolorosa**, we will be honoring our patron Our Lady of Sorrows at those two Masses. This year is the proper day because it is already on a Sunday. The lectors will still proclaim the readings of 24th Sunday of Ordinal Time since the only proper reading is the Gospel. The priests will proclaim the Gospel proper to the local Solemnity of Our Lady of Sorrows and use the proper prayers and vestments. As you've been seeing in the bulletin, help is needed to prepare food to continue the celebration after Mass. The other two parishes in our grouping will celebrate the 24th Sunday of Ordinary Time.

Then, on **Sunday, October 20, at St. Wendelin** we will honor the patron saint whose proper day is usually October 22. The lectors and priests will still proclaim the readings of 29th Sunday of Ordinal Time since there are no proper readings. The prayers and vestments, however, will be proper to St. Wendelin. The annual St. Wendelinfest is the previous Friday. The other two parishes in our grouping will celebrate the 29th Sunday of Ordinary Time.


Then again, on **Thursday, March 19, 2020, at St. Joseph** we will celebrate Joseph, Husband of Mary on the proper day rather than move it to Sunday since Sundays of Lent take precedence and since this day is already a Solemnity in all parishes across the world. We will have a Mass and otherwise celebrate the day if we find enough help to prepare. It's early but call the office if you are interested in helping.



Liturgical Trivia

Every Holy Day of Obligation is a Solemnity; Christmas, for example. A Solemnity is the highest ranking celebration, followed by a Feast, then a Memorial, then an Optional Memorial, then a Votive. The rank helps determine which celebration should be observed when there are more than one on the same day. So, while September 15 is indeed usually the day for Our Lady of Sorrows, Sunday (always a Solemnity) takes precedence ... except in parishes where she is the Patron.

This year, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is bumped from December 8 by the Second Sunday of Advent. As our nation's patron, we do not skip the observance, but we move it in the U. S. to the next day, Monday December 9. The obligation, though, does not transfer.


Chinese Auction Baskets


Catholic Identity Program

This program highlights a variety of virtues and values through short lessons, prayers, Scripture references, and more.

This week's Virtue is:

COURAGE

Courage is the ability to face difficulties and overcome fear with faith.



REFERENCE: VATICAN CITY

"Christians must be courageous when praying to God and not simply repeat prayers 'like a parrot,'" Pope Francis says. "In common parlance, people use an expression that I really like when they have a goal: 'I put it all on the line.' In intercessory prayers, this also applies: 'I put it all on the line'; it is the courage to go forward. But perhaps the doubt may arise: 'I do this, but how do I know the Lord listens to me?' We have a certainty: Jesus. He is the great intercessor." The Pope spoke these words during a homily earlier this year. The Bible, he said, is full of examples of holy men and women who prayed fervently to God, almost as if "they were arm-wrestling" with Him. They do so, he explained, because they "had faith that the Lord would give them grace."

Jesus, too, Pope Francis says, "prays for us at this moment" and no matter what way Christians pray, it is Christ "who takes my prayer and presents it to the Father. Jesus does not need to speak before the Father: He shows Him His wounds. The Father sees His wounds and gives us the grace," Pope Francis says. "When we pray, let us remember that we do it with Jesus. When we do a courageous prayer of intercession, we do it with Jesus."
